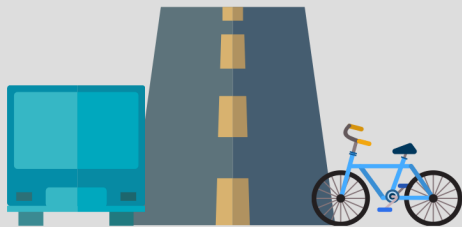

FUND TRANSPORTATION

State general transportation revenue is crucial for Portland's transportation funding, and a broad coalition is assembling a funding package that can pass this year.



MAINTAIN PUBLIC EMPLOYEE PENSIONS

With budget shortfalls, Oregon PERS has been a frequent target in the past, and we will work to protect benefits for past, current, and future public employees.



SUPPORT REVENUE REFORM

Oregon has a structural revenue problem, and the Oregon Legislature has not provided a fix since the passage of tax-limiting voter initiatives in the 1990's.



STRENGTHEN LABOR STATUTES

Oregon public employees should have stronger protections against unfair management bargaining tactics, better abilities to organize, and stricter rules protecting their work from privatization.
