Sandy Owen discussed child immunization rates. Benton and Franklin counties have a combined immunization rate of 92.8% of all children entering kindergarten. Our immunization rate is higher than that of Yakima County by approximately 8-12%.

Budget appears to be on "target". Hiring of an Administrator for BFHD was discussed.

Canal Building: Fred Bowen, FC Administration, indicated that requests for proposals have been accepted to determine if it would be cost effective for a county agency (other than BFHD) to remodel and occupy the Canal Building.

Items Voted Upon During Meeting

Members approved the creation of an Administrative position for the Health District with a salary range of \$90-110,000. Members also approved a WIC spending request, all vouchers and agreed to make the Human Resources Position 1.0 FTE instead of the current 0.8 FTE.

Commissioner Peck suggested that a salary of \$90-110,000 for Admin. Position was a bit "high". Bruce Perkins recommended that the BOH not rush into hiring an Administrator.
